- > District Deputy 1, Robert Hack, will be taking a leave of absence from his duties following recent medical complications. Worthy Deputy Gene Ziemba will serve as District Deputy 1 in his absence.
- With the permission of the Church, this Council is investigating the purchase of an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) as well as Cardio-pulmonary classes for St. Therese parishioners. This training and medical equipment could provide lifesaving support in the case of a cardiac incident. Additional information regarding the type and cost of the AED and training is being investigated. The funding could be covered through any fundraising event with the approval of the Council.
