## **NEW BUSINESS:**

The basic cost is about \$250-344 per box with a minimum order of 5 boxes with the sixth box free (possibly \$1720.00). The Grand Knight took the action to work with the District Deputy to determine the local demand in quantity and weight of

coats needed and report back to the Council so that a reasonable commitment can be made once the results of our current fundraising events are known.

The District has challenged Councils to increase their Financial Support of LAMB. Specifically, asking Saint Therese to move from \$500.00 to 1,00.00. A motion was made, seconded and carried to make the donation-in our next Charity Distribution following our Fall Fundraising events

The Grand called for establishing a Budget Line in the amount of \$500.00 for Bereavement Receptions should it be needed. While the Parish has the lead responsibility for working with the family and a standing Committee budgeted and staffed with volunteers to host these type receptions. On occasion the Committee lacks enough time to respond. This line item would be used for the Council, as a contingency, to help when one of our own can't be supported by the Committee. A motion was made, seconded and carried to budget the amount.
